

Congregations Seeking Partners

Magyarsáros (Delenii), Transylvania

The Unitarian Church of Magyarsáros is made up of kind-hearted, soulful people who are dedicated to their Unitarian roots and beliefs. Located in a rural area north of Medgyes in central Transylvania, they have a beautiful church built in 1904 (their fourth church building) and a wood tower built in 1600.

Sixty-five to seventy people of all ages gather each week for Sunday services; attendance grows to 180-250 for special holiday services. Children are a centerpiece of the congregation's life.

Rev. László-Csaba Jenei became minister of the church in 2014. He lives in Magyarsáros with his wife Ildiko and their two children. Both László and Ildiko are fluent in English, as are some of the young people who attend university.



Magyarsáros was partnered with a Massachusetts congregation in the 1920s in the old sister church program and briefly with a Rhode Island congregation in the early 1990s. They are hoping that this time a long-term partnership will take root. They are looking for a partner congregation with whom they can exchange ideas, thoughts, spiritual paths and experiences. They are hoping that their children and their partner's children will find a place in the partnership.
