NOMINATION PROCESS FOR LOUIS C. CORNISH “LIVING THE MISSION” AWARD

Each year the UUPCC Board accepts nominations received by Mar 1 for the annual Louis C. Cornish “Living the Mission” Award. A UUPCC committee will then make recommendations to the UUPCC Board. We hope you will give careful thought to whom you might wish to nominate for this great honor. The following guidelines may be helpful in your deliberations:

The award is named for Louis C. Cornish, early twentieth century president of the American Unitarian Association. Dr. Cornish was a visionary internationalist who devoted much of his life to forging global bonds for liberal religious groups. He headed a task force on human rights for ethnic Hungarians in Romania, and visited the Philippines to initiate connections with Unitarians there. In the spirit of Dr. Cornish, the award recipient should have made significant contributions to international relationships.

The recipient should have made an outstanding contribution to global church partnership, and to the partner church movement. The contribution should be, as nearly as possible, of the same magnitude as the contributions made by previous recipients. The recipient should not be a current member of the Partner Church Council Board of Directors.

All nominations are appreciated. Please include with your nomination a brief statement describing the contributions and attributes of the nominee, as well as contact information for yourself and the nominee.
