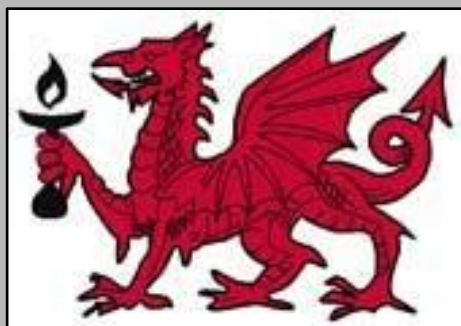

Learn about dissenting ministers, the "Black Spot" and the 1876 "Lock-Out" when Unitarians were evicted from their chapel for supporting liberal causes.

Our tour begins at the heart of what it means to be Welsh. Two days at the National Eisteddfod a showcase of music, dance, visual arts, literature, original performances and so much more. We close our time together with a visit to Pen-rhiw [Unitarian] chapel at St. Fagan's Natural History in Cardiff.
