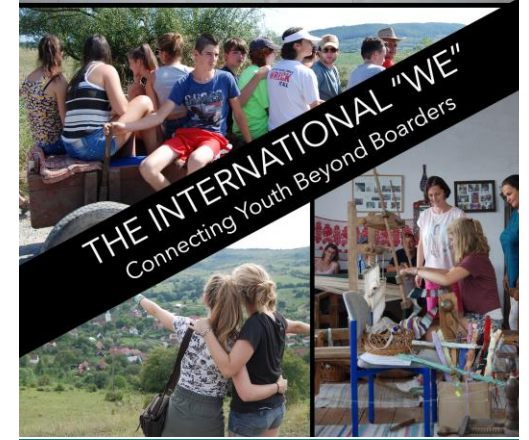

Unitarian Church in Gyepes, Transylvania

Purpose

To create a pilgrimage and youth camp for Unitarian Universalist youth from the United States and Hungarian Unitarian youth from Transylvania. During the camp, we intend to foster community through encouraging personal connections between cultures and empowering youth through discussion groups, home visits with locals, camp games, etc. We will create an itinerary of culturally and religiously significant sites in Unitarianism to help them grow in their own spirituality and knowledge. We will work with the Hungarian Unitarian community to identify a service project for collaboration by both Unitarian and UU youth. Before the camp, we will work with youth and their advisors to ensure their cultural competency and preparedness for an intense and transformational journey.
