Dear Mr. Perrone:

I am writing to you in my capacity as the in country representative of the Unitarian Universalist Partner Church Council in support of the tourist visa application of Rev. and Mrs. Mihály Kiss. They will present themselves at the United States Consulate on May 3, 2016.

Rev. Kiss and his wife Rozália have been invited by their partner congregation, the Unitarian Universalist Church in Livermore, California, to participate in the 50th anniversary celebration of the Livermore church. The partnership between the Livermore church and the Unitarian church of Sanvasii dates back to the early 1990s. Rev. Kiss and Rozália will conduct services and use this opportunity to meet with the leadership of the congregation to plan the future direction and activities of their partnership. Their current itinerary has them departing for the U.S. in mid-May and returning to Romania one month later in mid-June.

Rev. Kiss is a senior minister of the Hungarian Unitarian Church in Romania. He has served the congregation in Sanvasii for more than 30 years, and has extensive ties to the community. The Kisses were guests of the Livermore congregation 6 years ago, and honored the terms of their visa during that visit. I am confident that they will do so again, and that their visit will bear further fruit in both the United States and Romania.
